Scholarship Criteria and Application Process

Eligibility Criteria

In order to be eligible for the Judith B. Cabrita Tourism Professional Scholarships, applicants must be:

- Pursuing a professional development opportunity to enhance their skills or career path within the tourism industry **OR** pursuing the National *emerit* Tourism Certified Professional (TCP) Designation.
- Employed in the Nova Scotia tourism industry (a minimum of one year).

How to Apply

Applicants are to submit the following items:

- Letter of Introduction telling us about yourself and the professional development opportunity you are interested in pursuing - either *emerit* National Certification **OR** professional development (ie. conference, training, or educational program). The letter should incorporate how the opportunity will enhance job knowledge and improve career goals.
- Letter of support from your employer and current resume.

Applications are accepted throughout the year and are reviewed by the NSTHRC Scholarship Committee on an individual basis.
